You will not receive advertising or promotional material on this list.

MIAAP may use "cookie" technology to obtain non-personal information from its online visitors. We do not extract personal information in this process nor do we provide this information to third parties. We also do not contact you based on information in your cookie file.

MIAAP has taken steps to make all information received from our online visitors as secure as possible against unauthorized access and use. No personal identifier information is stored or collected. All information is protected by our security measures, which are periodically reviewed.
